

Dress Code

Student dress at Edgewood is expected to reflect the school and self-pride we are attempting to instill in all our students. The staff at Edgewood believes it is in the best interests of the students and the instructional program if we set some guidelines for the students. This list is in addition to the MCSD Dress Code found in the Behavior Code and Discipline Policy. Please go over these carefully.

1. Shirts must be buttoned.
2. Hats, hoods, and caps may not be worn in the building or classroom.
3. Shorts may be worn by all students in hot weather. Shorts must be no shorter than 3" above the knee in grades 4-5. No short shorts, bicycle or sport shorts.
4. Girls should not wear halters or show bare midriffs. Blouses and pants or skirts should meet at the waistline.
5. See through blouses, tank tops & fishnet shirts are not allowed.
6. Students may not wear cleated shoes, shower shoes, flip-flops, or bedroom shoes.
7. Students may not wear oversized pants with or without a belt.
8. No T-shirts which advertise alcoholic beverages, use or suggest violence or profanity, or which are suggestive, offensive or vulgar are allowed. Undershirts may not be worn alone.
9. Body piercing should be limited to ears.
10. Students may wear hooded jackets during school as long as the hood is not worn in doors
11. Bookbags are to be clear with no rolling wheels.
